KNOWN ISSUES

Items that are labeled known issues are generally issues that are not regressions, and exist currently in production. We are finding more of these issues due to increased test coverage with every release. The goal is to eventually have zero unknown defects.

We assign non-regression issues to the next open iteration.

- 3653 – You can't upgrade from pre-5.28 version to 5.31
- Redirect Issue
- 3685 – Appearance of "invalid PIN code" during Direct account activation
- 4431 – Rich Text in Chrome
- Inserting hyperlink into any browsers except I.E 11
