PRIVATE IDENTITY PROVIDER LOGIN FOR MOBILE SITE

The private identity provider (Okta) has been added as a login option for the mobile website for those customers who have this form of login enabled.

MESSAGING API FUNCTION GET MESSAGE METADATA IMPROVED

The Secure Messaging API function GetMessageMetadata has been improved to also give the email Subject when returning a response.

PASSWORD REQUIREMENTS WILL NO LONGER ALLOW USERNAME OR EMAIL

The password requirements will no longer permit users to utilize their usernames or emails as passwords to access their accounts.

Expired messages not automatically removing.	Expired messages were not being automatically sent to Trash. This has been fixed.	None.
