NEW FEATURES IN THIS RELEASE

WEB HOOKS

Web hooks are now available on the DataMotion platform for all customers to receive new message notifications as REST API calls to customer-defined endpoints. There is a set of options and configurations available for using web hook related features for both tenants and user types on the platform. Custom header configuration for these web hooks is also possible.

CHANGES AND ENHANCEMENTS MADE IN THIS RELEASE

IMPROVED LANGUAGE SUPPORT

Improved language translation for Spanish and French languages. This is the most helpful for international users and on-prem customers with foreign language requirements.

SECURITY IMPROVEMENT

Set the SameSite attribute for the HttpCookie to “strict” in code instead of web config. This provides no functional changes but is a moderate security improvement for the web portal.

RESOLVED ISSUES

The following-reported issues have been resolved in this release. If this a Maintenance Release, the most recent Maintenance Release is listed first. (Note that some Maintenance Releases may not be listed because they do not always require documentation).

Table 1. Resolved Issues

Original Issue	Description/Resolution	Notes
Tenant admins were unable to enable MFA for sub-tenants.	Odd duplicate records were noticed in place for some tenants that enabled the MFA feature causing sub-tenant control to not work. This has been corrected.	Affects web portal configuration of multi-factor authentication. Addresses ticket#10205130.
Messages downloaded as pdf were corrupt.	Active user session was not being associated with the downloaded message. This has been fixed.	Affects the Download option on the View Message page in the web portal. Addresses ticket#10207830.
Installer for the Outlook button (64-bit) was being interrupted.	Some installations of the Outlook button, 64-bit version, were failing to install due to interruptions. This has been fixed.	Affects the Outlook button from the Client Downloads page in the web portal. Addresses ticket#10205679.
Navigating to Compose would trigger an event error.	The event viewer logs would show an error whenever users navigated to the Compose page. This has been fixed.	Affects web portal and event viewer logs on the server (only applicable for on-prems).
