This release note provides information about the DataMotion SecureMail Release 5.51. The release information includes a summary of new features, issues resolved, and known limitations. This release marks the inclusion of a number of new features including multi-factor authentication and SAML based authentication. Please be aware that **Internet Explorer is no longer supported as of this release**.

NEW FEATURES IN THIS RELEASE

SAML

This release marks the inclusion of SAML into the DataMotion platform. This feature can only be configured by administrators of a tenant on the platform and will allow the usage of SAML authentication for Single Sign On (SSO) after uploading a proper certificate to the system.

SAML API FUNCTIONS

With the inclusion of SAML into the platform, a set of APIs that can be utilized for authentication purposes have been included as well. These APIs can be utilized by any tenant that has been configured for SAML authentication.

SELF SERVICE CENTER

A full self service portal is being made available for this release that will allow users to manage all of their DataMotion products that they have signed up for.

MULIT-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION

This release marks the addition of multi-factor authentication to the DataMotion platform. Once configured it will be possible for users to receive an email or authenticator code to provide an extra layer of security for logging into the DataMotion platform.

REPLY TO FUNCTION

It is now possible to add a reply to header to messages in order to change the reply address for secure messages. This feature must be enabled on the sending user and all users who receive messages with the appropriate header will reply to the Reply To address included in the message by the sender, as opposed to the original sender's From address.



CHANGES AND ENHANCEMENTS MADE IN THIS RELEASE

REDESIGNED MOBILE SITE

The mobile website has been completely redesigned as of this release with a more modern look and feel. This site is fully compatible with any Android or Apple iOS device. Please note that the full site button previously located on the mobile site has been deprecated as of this release and will no longer be available.

SINGLE SIGN ON CHANGES

The single sign on identity providers made available to users for logging into the web portal have been changed as of this release. They now include the following choices:

- n Google
- n Apple
- n Microsoft/Office 365

MESSAGE NOTIFICATIONS CAN BE CUSTOMIZED FOR COMPANIES

The message notifications that are sent out as part of the standard message flow can now be customized for each company on the system.

SECURE CONTACT

It is now possible to embed subjects into Secure Contact links as of this release.

OUTLOOK ADD IN

The Outlook button add in has been upgraded to version 5.0.28 as of this release.

FILE UPLOADER

Multiple files can now be added at once on the Compose screen as of this release.

Web portal text editor border.	The text editor on the web portal Compose screen was able to extend beyond the header border and looked odd. This has been fixed.	Only affects the web portal.	
Signature on the web portal text editor	Sometimes adding a signature on the web portal text editor would cause the editor to disappear. This has been fixed.	Only affects the web portal.	
Incorrect POP3 timestamps	Messages received over POP3 would sometimes have incorrect timestamps. This has been fixed.	Only affects POP3. Fix for ticket#10190853	
Child co-branding issue. Child co-brands would sometimes show CBName must be unique error. This has been fixed.		Only affects the web portal. Fix for ticket#10190638	
SecureMail MID in notices	The MID variable of a message has been added to notices NoticeRegRec and NoticeUnregRec.	Fix for ticket#10192236	
Cipher issues from penetration test results	All cipher issues have been resolved.	Fix for ticket#10187104
