## CHANGES AND ENHANCEMENTS MADE IN THIS RELEASE

#### SECURE MESSAGING API - GETMESSAGEMETADATA

The GetMessageMetadata call in the Secure Messaging API was changed to better reflect the DateOpened field regarding SafeTLS based messages.

#### **USER TRANSFER**

It is now possible to re-send a transfer user request if a user does not receive or acknowledge the initial notification. An admin will have to attempt the transfer user process again and they will be shown the timestamp for the initial request, and a set of options to either cancel the request entirely or re-send the transfer request notice to the user again.





## **RESOLVED ISSUES**

Original Issue	Description/Resolution	Notes	
Hyperlinks embedding incorrectly.	When using the web portal to compose a message, typing in a hyperlink (e.g. datamotion.com) instead of copy and pasting would cause the hyperlink to embed the email itself not the link to the site. This has been fixed.	Affects the web portal's compose screen, specifically the message body text.	
Password Reset questions not acting appropriately.	This was related to the administrative company properties setting wherein the tooltip reflected vague information. This has been corrected.	Affects the web portal administrative tools section only.	
Expired messages were not always being deleted.	This has been corrected.	Affects all users.	
From and To emails not lining up on mobile.	The From and To email entries on the mobile site were not lining up properly with the To being tabbed in further than expected. This has been corrected.	Affects mobile site users only.	
Incorrect folder error on mobile.	0
